



EMCEE GUIDE

Week 3: Heated Up Outside the Zone

Countdown/Hangout (15 Seconds)

Purpose: When the countdown begins, prepare students to wrap up their free time and find their small group leader.

Sample Script:

Welcome to Loop! It's _____, your emcee, and I'm pumped to see you here today! Let's get this party started by going to our small groups to discuss the icebreaker.

Welcome (30 Seconds)

Purpose: Transition students from the icebreaker to worship.

Sample Script:

Okay, Loop! It sounds like you guys have eaten some spicy things! On three, yell out the spiciest answer you heard. One ... Two ... Three! Nice! Okay, our goal at Loop is to have fun, so to help us all do that, there are just three rules: Respect your leaders, respect others, and respect the room. Now, stay with your groups as we worship!

Transition to Message (30 Seconds)

Purpose: Transition students from worship to teaching video.

Sample Script:

Worshipping with you guys is my favorite! Speaking of things that are my favorite—let's check out another episode of The Loop Show! This week's episode is going to be fire emoji. Lit. Hot. All the things. Trust me, you'll see why. Let's heat things up with another episode all about courage!

Offering (60 Seconds)

Purpose: Recap teaching in one sentence. Explain offering and pray over it while it's collected.

Sample Script:

That was powerful! It takes courage to do what's right. Now, let's shift gears and worship God through our tithes and offerings. Why is that worship? Well, worship isn't just singing songs. It's anything we do that puts God first. Giving is a great way to do that because when we give, we're showing God that He matters to us more than money or stuff. It's not about the money; it's about our hearts. When we give, we're getting our hearts in the right place, and that is honoring to God.

God, help us have the courage to do what's right instead of what's easy. Help us stick to our beliefs and follow You. We pray that You would bless and multiply our offering. Use it to help people all over the world find out about You. In Jesus' name, amen.

Announcements (60 Seconds)

Purpose: Celebrate salvations, announce upcoming events, share series Bible Plan, and transition to activity.

Sample Script:

If you made a decision to follow Jesus, congratulations! Let your small group leader know so that they can celebrate with you and let your family know. Now, listen up for some announcements!

- Our **YouVersion Bible Plan** this week is called *What Courage Looks Like*. You can even do it with your group or with family and friends using Plans with Friends!
- 6th graders, if you're having fun in Loop, you've got to check out **Switch** on Wednesday nights at 6:30. It's super fun! Also, ask your small group leader about **Swerve**.
- Loop is more fun with friends, so invite your friends to come check it out next weekend.

Now, it's time for the best part of Loop—your small group time! We'll get things going with an activity you'll complete with your group.
