Week 3: Family Drama

Origami Heart

A unique way to show students how God can turn fussing and fighting into love.

Activity Objective

Draw your struggle, then turn it into an origami heart.

You'll Need

- Love Your Family activity sheet (1 per student)
- Pen or pencil (1 per student)

Instructions

Note: If any students draw or write anything that looks to be serious in nature, be sure to discreetly make sure someone from your campus staff is notified.

1. **Give** each student a Love Your Family activity sheet.
2. Students use scissors provided to **cut** off the instructions on the sheet, leaving behind a square of paper to use for drawing and for their origami folding.
3. Students **draw or write** representations of what tends to cause their family to feel irritated with one another and/or to cause fussing and fighting in their home.
4. When students have drawn or written a bit on their paper, **briefly pray together**. Pray something like this: *God, thank You for giving us families to live with. Help us to share Your love and forgiveness with them. Help each family represented here to be bound together with Your perfect love and harmony. In Jesus' name, amen!*
5. **If time allows**, students follow the origami folding instructions to create a heart to represent how God's love covers over our sins and binds us together.
