## Small Group Discussion

### YouVersion Bible Plan

Make sure students check out the Bible Plan associated with this series:

***God Can Give You Wisdom***

### Big Question

Where do you look for wisdom?

### Choose questions for your small group.

1. What stood out to you the most from the message? What's one thing you learned?
2. Today we learned that anyone can access wisdom. Where are some great places to find and learn wisdom? *Ideas: The Bible, Bible Plans, church, trusted leaders, parents, The Loop Show, etc.*
3. What would've made it easier for the blindfolded person in today's game? *Ideas: If they could filter out other voices so they could hear which voices were from their team, if they knew which instruction they heard was the correct instruction for them, etc.*
4. Read **Proverbs 3:6**. What do you think it means to seek God's will in everything you do?
5. Talk about a time when you made a foolish choice. How did it affect you or others? And how did you feel about it? *Encourage students to share freely. You might break the ice with an age-appropriate story of a time you made a foolish choice.*
6. Talk about a time you made a wise choice. How did it affect you or others? And how did you feel about it?
7. Pray together. Pray that your students would crave wisdom because they understand it leads to a better life all around. Pray that they would learn to hear and follow God's voice above all others.
