*How to Save the World*  
Week 2: Jesus Saves the World

### Verse Challenge

A fun way to learn today's Bible verse.

### Activity Objective

Be the first group to assemble your Bible verse.

### You'll Need

- Plastic eggs (18 per group)
- Bag (1 per group)
- Verse Challenge card set (1 per group)

## Instructions

**Before activity:** Fold 18 Challenge Cards and put them inside the 18 eggs as needed. Place eggs in the bag.

**Note:** This game is most fun when the whole room plays with all groups competing against one another for the fastest time. The emcee might be the best person to lead the game.

**Say:** Okay, Loop. Let's see who can be the fastest at putting together today's Bible verse. Your leader has a bag of eggs. Inside each egg are either words from our verse—or a challenge to complete! Your group has to draw out eggs one at a time. If it's a word from the verse, put it down in order. If it's a challenge, your **whole group** has to do the challenge. Then, you can draw your next egg. Anytime you need help with the words of the verse, ask your leader and they'll read the verse to you. The first team with their whole verse laid out in order wins! Ready? Go!

1. Groups draw an egg and read the paper inside it.
2. If it's a word from the verse, they place it in the middle of the group roughly where it belongs.
3. If it's a challenge, the whole group does the challenge. Do not draw another egg until the group has completed the challenge. **Note:** If anyone in your group has a physical disability, you can choose one person from your group to be your challenge completer!
4. Continue drawing eggs until the whole verse is assembled in front of you.
5. If an egg is empty, its contents may have spilled into the bottom of the bag. Continue drawing until all eggs are removed, then feel along the bottom of the bag for any missing papers.
6. If students ask, you may read them the verse:

**Romans 6:23 NLT** *For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.*

7. Celebrate the team who won the challenge with wild applause! Play again if time allows.
8. Replace papers inside eggs and return eggs to the bag when you're done so they'll be ready for any additional groups who play.
