How to Save the World
Week 3: Grace Picks You

Encouragement Cards

A tangible way for students to share God's love and grace with the world.

Activity Objective

Write out some encouraging words for someone who needs them.

You'll Need

- Encouragement Card activity sheet (1 per student)
- Pen or pencil (1 per student)
- Markers (1 set per group)

Instructions

Say: Today, we saw how some encouragement meant so much to Ricky and Jayme. We know God can use us to boost His grace to others. So, let's take a moment and pray about how God might help us do that.

1. Students **bow heads** and **close eyes**.

Pray: God, help each student here to think of one person right now who they can encourage. Maybe that person is going through a hard time. Maybe they're not! We just ask for You to just place a person in the mind of each student right now. And help each student to think of some ways to let that person know how God has made them awesome.

2. **Give** each student an Encouragement Card activity sheet.
3. Students **write** words of encouragement for the person they chose.
4. Students **decorate** cards with remaining time, using markers provided.
5. Students can **share** what they wrote—only if they would like to—as time allows.
6. Encourage students to bring their cards home and give them to the person who needs it. Students can ask their parents or guardians for help with mailing or delivering as needed.
